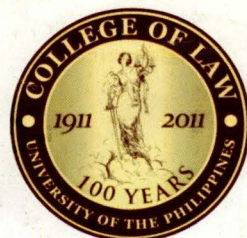

INTRODUCTION

THE FATEFUL JOURNEY OF UP LAW CLASS 1971. In nature, as in life, 99.9% of what happens to us is outside of or beyond our control, quite independent of our own merit or qualifications. More often than not, the blessings of fate and destiny are brought about by historical *happenstance* and *serendipity*.

What are the chances that, over a period of several generations, the confluence of disparate historical events, both private and national, would lead to UP Law Class of 1971 acquiring this **original** copy of the 1935 Constitution and handing this supreme gift over to its *alma mater*, the UP College of Law?

HISTORICAL TIMELINE

- **1898:** PHILIPPINE REVOLUTION
USA defeats Spain and Philippines is ceded under the Treaty of Paris (August 1898). American era begins.
- **1903:** CORNELIO T. VILLAREAL: one of six delegates from Capiz to the Constitutional Convention and signatory to the 1935 Constitution is born. He was to father F. William L. Villareal (UP LAW 71) who, years later, was offered this original copy of the 1935 Constitution through the Philippine Numismatic and Antiquarian Society (PNAS).
- **1908:** UNIVERSITY OF THE PHILIPPINES (Act No. 1870)
- **1911:** UP COLLEGE OF LAW
- **1929:** PHILIPPINE NUMISMATIC AND ANTIQUARIAN SOCIETY (PNAS)
- **1934-35:** CONSTITUTIONAL CONVENTION meets to draft the Philippine Constitution of 1935
- **1971:** FIRST QUARTER STORM
UP Law Class of 1971 graduates.
- **1972:** MARTIAL LAW declared (Proclamation 1081)
UP Law Class 71 is on watch (latest batch of lawyers) when President Ferdinand E. Marcos (UP Law 1939) suspends/amends the Constitution.

Historical Timeline

- **1973:** NEW CONSTITUTION approved through people's referendum.
 - **1986:** PEOPLE POWER REVOLUTION
Constitutional Commission convenes.
 - **1987:** 1987 CONSTITUTION (arguably new) ratified.
 - **Present:** Renewed attempts to amend the Constitution in a period of increased international turmoil.

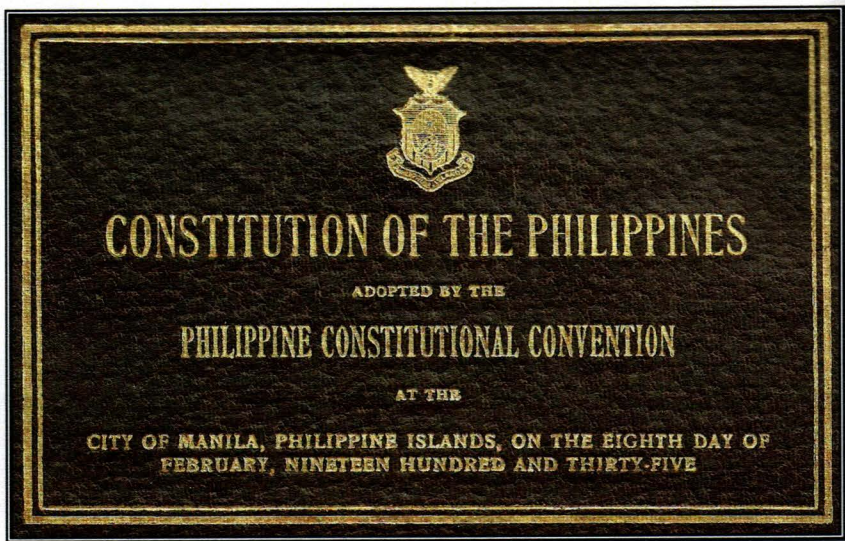
